The Conímbriga – Hotel do Paço, recently acquired, is an example of this strategy, similar to what happens with the Hotel Parque Serra da Lousã, Serra da Lousã Biological Park, Ecumenical Universalist Temple and Chanfana Museum Restaurant. CONÍMBRIGA – HOTEL DO PAÇO

Conímbriga – Hotel do Paço was recently renovated and takes place on a building with a history dating back to the 18th century. With a charming atmosphere and surrounded by a garden vase, it is the perfect place for a quiet and unforgettable break.

Located in the village of Condeixa, at 1H30 from Porto Airport and Lisbon Airport, you are just a few minutes away from the Unesco World Heritage city of Coimbra.

Next to the Hotel, you will find the mythical ruins of Conímbriga, the PO.RO.S Museum and the iconic and intriguing Buracas do Casmilo.

A historical place full of charm, refinement and tranquility. This space was formerly the Almadas Palace. The roots of this palace date back to the 14th century. The building, wich is considered one of the most important of Condeixa, was restructured in XIX. In 1993, it underwent deep works and was transformed into Hotel. Since 2019, is the 4 **** Hotel Conimbriga—Hotel do Paço.

Here, there were lodged individualities of the most distinguished nobility and European royalty. Some of the special guests of the former palace were King D. Manuel I in 1500, D. Catarina, on his return to the Kingdom after the death of his husband Charles II of England in 1704, D. Pedro II, Charles of Austria and, finally, the infant of Spain D. Carlos, brother of King Fernando VII.



Hotel Parque Serra da Lousã, on the other hand, it's a 4 star hotel unit. The hotel is all in brille and has 9 rooms with facilities for people with reduced mobility. Family-friendly and bike friendly, the unit is located in Miranda do Corvo, very close to Serra da Lousã. The Hotel & Spa is 15 minutes away from Coimbra and 1H45 away from Lisbon and Porto airports. Right next to the Serra da Lousã Biological Park and to the Ecumenical and Universalist Temple, the hotel unit is a few minutes away from the Gondramaz Schist Village. 
SERRA DA LOUSÃ BIOLOGICAL PARK

Located on the slopes of Serra da Lousã, this Park is the largest sample of wildlife of Portugal and it was created with the objective of assist in the conservation of the species that inhabit or inhabited the Portuguese territory.
